Pseudomonas aeruginosa

Also called: P. aeruginosa Say it: Sudo-mo-nas Air-u-gin-osa

About: High resistance to many antibiotics and can cause life-threatening infections. Generally occurs in people in hospital or among those with weakened immune systems.¹

Shape: Rod¹

Potential threats include:

Urinary tract infections, sepsis and pneumonia¹

One way to help fight this Superbug:

Use antibiotics as directed by your doctor²
